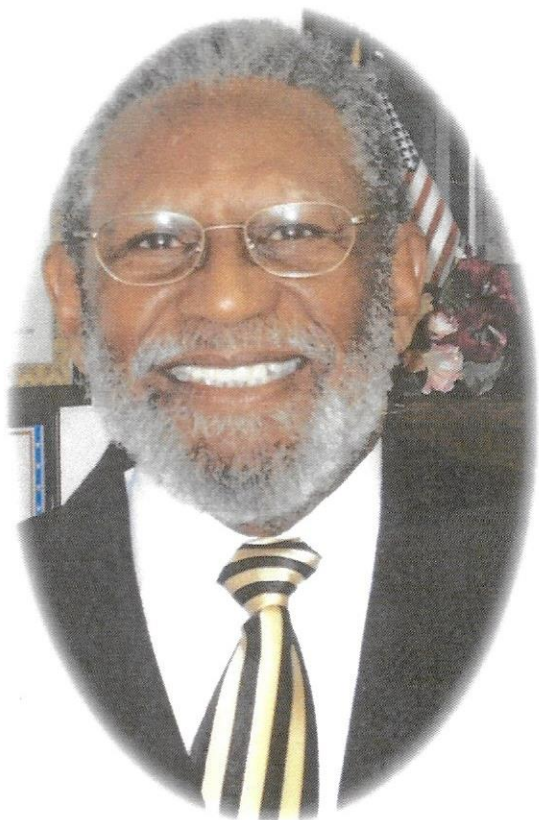

# Obituary

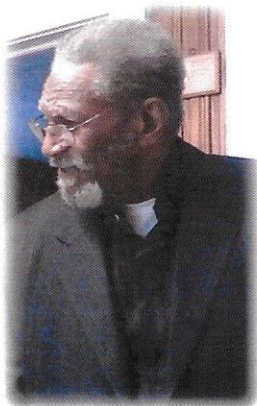
William Frederick Hines Jr. born on August 5, 1930, went home to be with the Lord early Sunday morning August 29, 2021, he was 91 years old.

William F Hines Jr. was born in Durham NC, the son of William Frederick Hines, Sr. and Etheline Jordan Hines. He was raised in Durham and a graduate of Hillside High School, class of 1949.

William enlisted in the United States Army on January 31<sup>st</sup>, 1951, serving as a Med Tech till he was honorably discharged January 29, 1953. He received the Korean Service Medal with one Bronze Service Star and the United Nations Service Medal. He served his country well.

After leaving the Army, William was employed with the Lyons Veterans Affairs Hospital in Lyons NJ as a Nurse Assistant. He was also an entrepreneur with a lawn care business that serviced his community and neighboring cities. He met Brazzie Mae Bryant while working at Lyons, they married and out of that union was born a son, William F Hines III (1968).

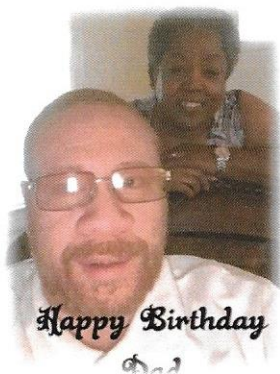
William F Hines Jr., Pop Hines, Deacon Hines, was a man of faith that loved the Lord. He was a member of First Baptist Church of South Bound Brook for 60 years joining at the age of 31 on August 13, 1961. He served well and as a result was ordained as a Deacon in 1969. In his 52 years of selfless servitude, three Pastors were blessed by his support. Deacon Hines was elevated to Chairman – and led the church 1996-1997 in seeking a new Pastor. He was dedicated to his church family; he took his commitment to the Lord and the church serious.



He served on the General Board {Executive} and ministered to the sick & shut-in members serving in-home communion every first Sunday until he was unable to. He developed a strong Deacon Ministry by cultivating the men trusted to his leadership. He regularly attended Bible Study and led Wednesday Night Prayer Service. He could be heard joyfully singing a hymn early in the morning as he filled the Baptism pool for each baptism. He diligently served Pastor Bright and his family with respect and love and was a recipient of the same. In his humility, he could be found donating his lawn care services to keep the grounds of the church in pristine condition. Deacon Hines shared special relationships with the youngest to the oldest members and bridged generational gaps. They were as much his family as his natural family.

Preceding him in death is: his wife Brazzie Mae Hines, sister, Ethel Juanita Hines Sims, and granddaughter, Felicia Foster.

He is survived by: a daughter, Wanda Gail Foster of Durham NC; a son, William F Hines III of Maryland; two grandsons, William F. Hines IV and Zachariah Joseph Hines; a great grandson, Aaron T. Foster of Maryland; a sister, Phyllis Nuchurch of Durham, NC; three nieces, three nephews, and a host of relatives, special friends, and church family.



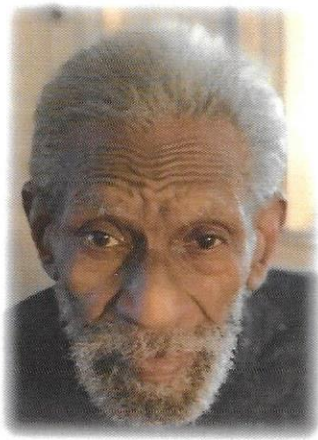

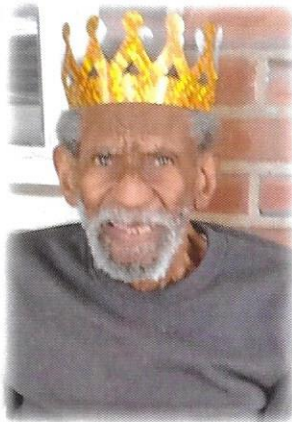
