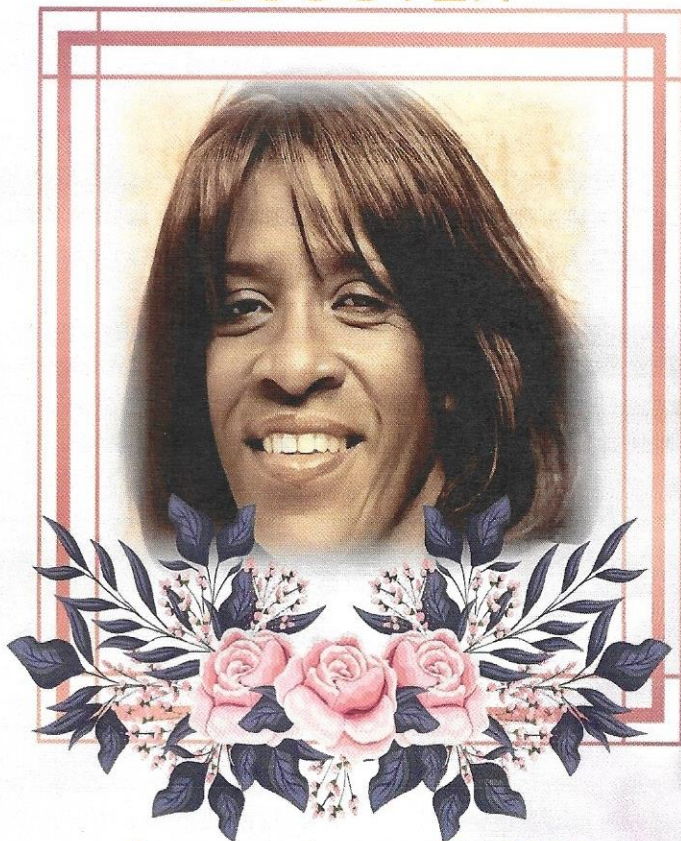

Scooters Life Journey

Sunday, June 25, 1950 a gift was born to Mr. Edward Webb and Ms. Helen Washington here in the city of Durham on the Southside.

Her journey was completed Thursday, August 17, 2023 at Duke Regional Hospital.

Scooter became a Hillside Hornet graduating in 1968 from Hillside High School. She continued her education at North Carolina Central University (NCCU) becoming an Eagle graduating in 1972.

From birth to 2023 she was an active member in St. Mark AME Zion Church participating in on the Stewardess Board, Assistant Class Leader, President of the Chancellor Chorus, Inspirational Voices and the Missionary Department.

After graduating from NCCU she was employed with Durham City schools now Durham Public Schools. Where she rose through the ranks and supervised the Chapel One Reading and Math curriculum for 13 different Schools. Believing that all children could excel ,she specialized in Reading and Math. After her retirement she continued her interest in children opening up "Lil Scooter's Angels" Daycare, in which she operated for 25 years. She enjoyed teaching, cooking, sewing and dance at Shepard Middle School and feeding the multitude as owner and operator of "Its Too Good" catering service. She was the founder of Joshua's Foundation which provided new school shoes for children who were in need. She enjoyed meeting, greeting and educating young people to vote.
