NAAHHS Homecoming Parade Guide

1. Participation in the Homecoming Parade is subject to the review and approval of the NAAHHS Homecoming Parade Committee in accordance with all local ordinances and state laws.
2. A parade participant whether he or she is operating a motor vehicle, riding in or on a parade unit, walking/marching, may not possess, transport, consume, distribute, or be under the influence of alcohol or other drugs at any time immediately prior to or during the parade.
3. All cars/trucks must be driven by a licensed driver.
4. All cars/trucks must have signage on both sides of the vehicle.
5. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
6. All motor vehicle must move at a safe and satisfactory speed or be subject to expulsion from the parade.
- 7. BURNOUTS/TIRE-SPINS BY MOTORCYCLES OR THREE/FOUR WHEELERS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED DURING THE PARADE**
- 8. THE HANDING OUT OF CANDY OR ANY FOOD OR DRINK IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
- 9. ANY MUSIC THAT IS BROADCASTED FROM AN ENTRY MAY NOT CONTAIN PROFANE OR OFFENSIVE LANGUAGE.**
- 10. Any entry that is displaying any graphics or artwork that cab be considered lewd, profane, or offensive by the Parade Committee will not be allowed in the parade line up.**
11. Only animals under the strict leash or bridle of a qualified animal handler will be permitted in the parade. The identified animal handler and his/her parade unit sponsor will bear any responsibility for any damages and injuries resulting from negligence or act of God incidents regarding the animal in question.
12. All horses must be equipped with diaper buckets. Street sweepers are not a suitable alternative.
13. Individuals cannot break the lineup at any time. Failure to comply with this directive will result in expulsion from the parade.
14. Marching units will not be allowed to "break down" or stop other than the three designated areas. The designated areas are in front of St. Joseph's AME Church, in front of the Food Lion Grocery store, and at the entrance of Hillside High School.
15. Each marching unit will have no more than two minutes for performing at the designated "break down" areas. Please plan for this activity to be exciting and entertaining.
16. All parade participants should begin to arrive and line up by 1:30 pm. The parade will begin promptly at 2:30 pm.
17. Parade staff will be site to assist with the lineup. Please respect their directions.

FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THESE GUIDELINES MAY RESULT IN THE IMMEDIATE REMOVAL OF THE PARTICIPANT OR PARADE UNIT FROM THE PARADE.
